

rst2pdf Sphinx pdf_break_level test

This test looks at what the pdf_break_level option does.

- pdf_break_level = 0: Everything is on a single page.
- pdf_break_level = 1: A new page after each section, but not sub-section
- pdf_break_level = 2: A new page after each section, *and* sub-section

To generate locally, run `sphinx-build -b pdf . ./pdf`

The next section

This is the next section of the document. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 1`.

The first sub-section

This is the first sub-section of the *next section*. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 2`.

The second sub-section

This is the second sub-section of the *next section*. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 2`.

The section after next

This is the section after next of the document. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 1`.

Another first sub-section

This is the first sub-section of the *section after next*. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 2`.

Another second sub-section

This is the second sub-section of the *section after next*. This will be on a new page if `pdf_break_level >= 2`.
